Important stuff

When is it? From 7pm Thursday 1st April til 12 noon, Monday 5th April. Please note that the first meal at the camp is breakfast Friday morning.

Where is it? Challenge Ranch, Hensons Rd, Somersby (on the Central Coast)

Who can go? If you're in Year 7 and up (to age 30), you're welcome to come along.

How will I get there? Transport from Gordon to Somersby and back will be in a convoy of private vehicles driven by leaders. Please arrive at the Church on Thursday night at 5pm as we will be leaving at 5.30pm sharp. Campers will return to the Church around 2pm on Monday afternoon. Campers also have the option of arranging their own transport to and from the camp.

How much? Before February 28 - \$175, Before March 31 - \$200, Optional Saturday afternoon activities are available at a cost of \$21. See the registration form for more information. Campers should also bring money to cover dinner on Thursday and lunch on Monday as will be stopping for these meals in Gosford.

Other info

Challenge Ranch has a variety of outdoor activities on offer including a hedge maze, swimming in the dam and volleyball. Other options will be available at an additional cost on the Saturday afternoon including archery, ropes course and flying fox.

There will also be a \$5 Vinnies VIP Dinner. The idea is that you buy an item of clothing - up to \$5 in cost - from Vinnies (or Salvo Store or Lifeline etc) and wear it to dinner on Saturday night.
